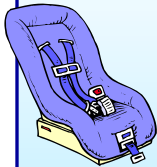

Heartland Community Action Agency's HEALTHY FOUNDATIONS PROJECT

has obtained a very rare XRF Monitor that will x-ray and monitor items for Arsenic, Bromine, Cadmium, Chlorine, Lead, and Mercury ~ toxic chemicals commonly used to make children's products.

The monitor will tell us if toxins are present and at what level.

Worried about Grandma's china? Lead painted wood trim in your home?

Bring it in and we'll test it for FREE!
